

Following the SAFE Unit's money trail

A LaSalle County SAFE Unit investigator issues a warning ticket to David Allen Fink Jr.

The SAFE Unit alerts the Illinois State Police to its \$50,000 cash seizure from Fink. The SAFE Unit is listed as the sole law enforcement agency participating in the seizure. The state police are directed to pay \$32,500 to SAFE as a result.

An Illinois State Police notice of forfeited funds distribution shows it paid \$32,500 to SAFE as a result of the Fink seizure.

A check issued to the SAFE Unit by the Illinois State Police for \$41,535 includes the \$32,500 portion of Fink's seizure.

A copy of the deposited check for \$41,535 shows it was signed over to the city of Spring Valley.

A deposit receipt from the Spring Valley "drug asset forfeiture fund" shows the \$41,535 check was deposited.
