WE'VE GOT YOUR NUMBER

Record-setting settlements and wrongful convictions helped define the 2018 JVR Settlements Report

he last year was a remarkable one for deals, and the 2018 JVR Settlements Report breaks the top ones down for you.

Each year, Chicago Lawyer and Jury Verdict Reporter — a sister publication within Law Bulletin Media — examine the top reported settlements. This year's report is based on \$1.5 billion in settlements of Illinois cases submitted to Jury Verdict Reporter between July 1, 2017, and June 30, 2018.

The report includes confidential settlements for which *Jury Verdict Reporter* editors were able to verify details between both parties. Settlements included in prior reports were not included. The law firms listed in the rankings are where the lawyers involved worked at the time of the deal — if a lawyer changed firms since the deal, the settlement doesn't come with them. If two or more firms reported the same dollar amount, they were given the same numerical ranking.

Starting in 2016, the threshold for consideration was moved from only charting settlements of \$2 million or more down to all settlements of \$500,000 or more. While the big-dollar deals make headlines, the bulk of the work is done on smaller cases. Justice doesn't need to have seven figures to help an injured person move on with their lives.

Here are a few hot topics we found:

POWER ROGERS & SMITH

As it has for the last nine years, Power Rogers & Smith has topped the report. The Madison Street personal-injury firm brokered 24 settlements totaling nearly \$205 million. That's a 25 percent increase from the \$164 million in settlements that won them the top spot last year.

TIERNEY DARDEN

One of the most talked-about settlements of the past year was the \$115 million settlement Salvi, Schostok & Pritchard obtained for Tierney Darden. The largest reported personal-injury settlement for an individual in Illinois' history, *Tierney Darden v. City of Chicago*, et al., 15 L 8311, came after Chicago vowed to appeal a \$148 million jury verdict, itself the largest Cook County personal-injury verdict ever reported.

WRONGFUL CONVICTIONS

Civil rights cases — specifically cases related to wrongful convictions or police abuse — have gained prominence in the list.

We talked with the Roderick & Solange MacArthur Justice Center and the law firm of Loevy & Loevy to discuss if these cases are an emerging trend, or the last vestiges of Chicago's history of police abuse, cleared by new DNA evidence?

NINE YEARS AND RUNNING

Power Rogers & Smith founding partner Joe Power has one piece of advice: Take deposition

"Historically, since I started practicing, when the lawyers start getting older they delegate more," Joe Power said.

Handing over deposition chores isn't passing off grunt work to the younger lawyers, Power said. It's giving up a chance to size up your opponents' experts face to face, "getting a feel of where I need to lay off and where I need to push."

It's a simple admonition Power said that has helped his firm top the JVR Settlements Report for a record nine years in a row.

Power gave as an example Robert Montagano, et al., v. Leading Edge Group Inc., et al., 14 L 8096, in which a Cook County jury awarded \$85 million to a man who had both legs amputated after a crane accident at a Rockford construction site. Rather than go through the appeal process, the firm brokered a \$44.8 million settlement, the firm's largest of the year and the second-highest in this report.

In deposition, Power realized how impressive his opponents' experts were, so he knew he should start with a full-frontal assault rather than chip away with subtlety.

"You don't go after them on their battleground," he said. "You pick your own battleground. You pick the place where the fight is going to start. And knowing they're smart, devious and formidable, you pick another battleground to start on."

The firm's lawyers brought in \$204,952,784 in settlements over the report year. Power said there's no particular way a lawyer is expected to handle a case, just that they work six days a week when not on trial, seven days a week when on trial.

"In my opinion, maybe that's why we are nine years in a row," he said. "We're all working on cases."
